Rebrand: Former „neska Container Line B.V.“ becomes „HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V.“

- **New name highlights affiliation with the Cologne-based HGK Group**
- **Container transport on the Rhine under "HGK Container Line" flag**

Cologne / Dordrecht. Under new name, but with the same business model and main points of contact former "neska Container Line B.V." is now operating under the name "HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V." based in Dordrecht. This rebranding underlines the company's affiliation with HGK Logistics and Intermodal GmbH, headquartered in Cologne. The new concept was presented yesterday to customers, business partners, and stakeholders during a joint event in Rotterdam.

The Dutch logistics service provider has been organising container transports by barge and rail between the major ARA seaports of Rotterdam and Antwerp and the container terminals of HGK Logistics and Intermodal along the Rhine and Ruhr since 1988. HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V. focuses on the efficient combination of barge, rail and lorry for its container transport services. The company offers customers a complete package for handling import and export transport. Support is provided for the organisation of import declarations or transit documents, amongst other things. Real-time data allows customers to always stay informed about the location and time frames of their shipments. These services lead to better planning, time savings, and the avoidance of delays.

"By rebranding the company to 'HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V.' the subsidiary is now officially and visibly part of the HGK Group. This has more than just a symbolic significance for us," explains Markus Krämer, CEO of HGK Logistics and Intermodal GmbH. He adds: "With its expertise in container transport by water, HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V. is a key component of the range of services that we offer as a group for supply chain and warehousing solutions."

With the change of name, HGK Group is also emphasising the importance of the seaport connection for the intermodal logistics activities of HGK Logistics and Intermodal GmbH. Hans Buytendijk, Managing Director of "HGK Logistics and Intermodal Nederland B.V.", highlights: "Supply chains are becoming increasingly complex. We see ourselves as the interface

between the seaports and the hinterland." Container transport along the Rhine will continue to be organised and operated under the "HGK Container Line" brand by the Dordrecht site.
